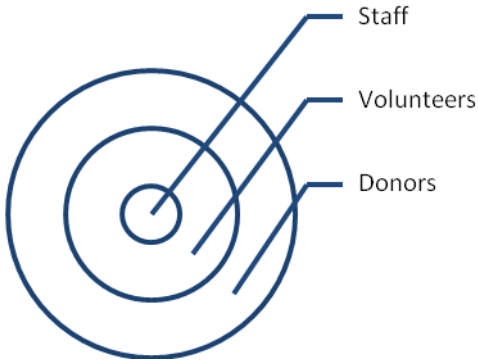


Who Supports BACN



The Bay Area Crisis Nursery is a privately funded non-profit organization that receives no government funding. We do not seek federal, state, or county funds because such sources often require proof that abuse has occurred before services can be provided. Our proactive approach enables parents in crisis to seek help before an incident occurs.

With an annual operating budget of just under 1 million dollars, we rely completely on donations from individuals, businesses, the faith community, clubs and organizations, private foundations and from fundraising efforts. It is through the generosity of the overall community that we can continue to provide safety for the children and support for parents during times of stress or crisis.

One of the key initiatives currently underway is the “Circle of 25” group. This group is comprised of donors who have made a cumulative donation of \$25,000.00. Our hope is to honor 25 donors into this benevolent circle.
