## 2010 Annual Review

This year's most memorable event was easy to identify – for me it was an opportunity to travel in France – for BACN it was a trial run to answer the question “What happens when Sister Ann is not here at BACN?” In the area of challenges BACN continued to deal with the legislative issues and financial stability. For the families we serve 2010 saw continually increasing needs which due to your ongoing generous support we were able to meet.

On June 7<sup>th</sup>, early in the morning, I left BACN with only a twenty inch rolling suitcase, a backpack, Jewel our canine mascot and a bag of dog food. I was headed for Los Angeles to meet up with ten other Sisters of Saint Joseph – one from Hawaii and nine from California. I stopped in Tracy to deliver Jewel to Sherie her foster mom then continued on to L.A. After prayer, dinner, celebrations and a good night's sleep we boarded an Air France plane which transported us to Charles de Gaulle airport where we meet three more sisters – two guides and a sister from Japan. The 14 of us began our 10 day pilgrimage to Lyon, LePuy and Paris. In Lyon we prayed at the gravesite of our founder, we toured the town, sampled French cuisine and learned about the reestablishment of our religious order after the French Revolution. In LePuy we prayed in the original kitchen where our first Sisters gathered and prepared meals for the orphans. We went to the community archives, visited the Cathedrals, visited the lace making shops and climbed, higher than I ever imagined possible, to the top of volcanic rock structures to visit chapels and statues. Our trip ended in Paris where we visited spectacular

cathedrals, went to the top of the Eiffel Tower, visited the Louvre, Musee d'Orsay and Notre Dame. Of course we found time for an evening river cruise, souvenir shopping and fine dining. With a bit of sorrow in our hearts we said our goodbyes, flew back to L.A. and I returned to the Nursery on June 20<sup>th</sup>. Before this pilgrimage I had never traveled outside the US. Before this pilgrimage I had never been away from the Nursery for more than seven days – for 14 days BACN was fine.

My trip to France proved that the Nursery does just fine without me. Ever since we opened almost 30 years ago donors have been asking what will happen to the Nursery if Sister Ann is not here. Often a Founder/ Director staying around for a long time makes the organization dependent on the personality of the individual. This can cause problems when that person leaves. We have tried to avoid this by doing succession

planning since the mid nineties. We started by forming a three member management team – executive director, program manager & development director. There was cross training in each of the positions so that the loss of one member could be covered during the job search. When we opened the Dahlstrom House we added a fourth member. This was our little “dream team”. The team members had a variety of ages and skill sets. The loss of anyone, including the executive director would not jeopardize the operation of BACN. Today I am the only one left of that “dream team”. With succession planning, we have found the only thing we can count on is change. During 2010 we lost a very special

member of the management team, Gwen Dwiggins. In November she went on medical leave and recently she lost her battle with cancer. We can't replace a dynamic, loving, committed person like Gwen, but we will find that person who will enable us to continue our services to the families of our community. Succession planning means planning for change - we do that continually.

Legislative issues move slowly. During 2010 we had a meeting with CCL in May to address the request for two waivers that we had submitted. These waivers requested grandfathering in the staff hired before the new regulations as regards educational requirements and training and exemption from some volunteer training requirements. We have not receive a positive or negative reply to date however we are working on a better volunteer training program and all staff hired after the regulations have proper training and education. A bill passed in 2010 that extended the sunset date of the crisis nursery regulations to 2014. We are currently starting the process of identifying what changes are needed to make these regulations workable for all existing crisis nurseries. I have a list of people interested in helping with legislative issues. We have started to build up a network to help us through this process. I will keep you updated.

The financial situation has not turned around although it is starting to improve. In 2009 we dipped deeply into the reserves - \$183,000. In 2010 we did not dip as far into the reserves - \$138,000. Some businesses that in the past have donated services, due to the poor economy have had to start charging. We are working hard to add to the donor base. Through outreach we are attempting to obtain more material donations that will reduce our need to purchase materials. We are being extra vigilant that the monies donated are well use to serve the families of our community. Thank you for continuing to help.

As the economy continued to be difficult our families found greater difficulty providing food and shelter for their children. As many of you realized this, the flow of donations continued in amounts sufficient to cover the needs of our clients. Warm coats, blankets, food and clothing were provided for our families. Gas cards, BART cards, phone cards, motel nights and funds for the occasional special need continued to be available. Your generosity towards the families we serve has truly made a difference.

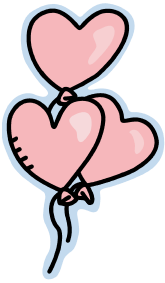
Thank you so much for being part of the wonderful community whose generosity helps us keep children safe and families together during times of stress and crisis.

## A Family Story

We received a call from a mother of four children under the age of 12. She had never used our services but had heard of our program from another family. Her children were two 10 year old boys (not twins), one 23 month old boy, and one 3 year old boy. She was requesting a stress break. The two older boys were both on medication for ADHD.

We did not have a time to admit the children in the Nursery on Friday and the mother was not in the immediate area so arrangements were made for her to admit all her children on Saturday morning. When she arrived on Saturday it was discovered that she was the adoptive mother of all four children. (One of the older children did not come – he was spending the weekend at his Grandmother's) so she was admitting one child to Dahlstrom House and two children to the Nursery. She shared with staff that she had one older child of her own and had adopted the four shortly after their births, bringing them directly home from the hospital. She and her husband had decided to have this family together; however, a short time ago, he moved out and she has been on her own.

She initially thought she could only bring the children in for 24 hours – from Saturday morning to Sunday morning but the staff called her and encouraged her to leave the children with us until Sunday evening. Staff also spoke with her about using our program once a month so she could get a much needed break. She was very grateful.

### THANK YOU EASTER BUNNY HELPERS

Eight groups gathered in March and April to make Easter Baskets. This event, open to youth groups, is one of the few volunteering opportunities to be found for those under 12 years old. About 75 youth made 300 Easter Baskets. The baskets go to children who come to BACN in the weeks before Easter and to client families who live nearby.
